NEWARK ARCHDIOCESAN YEAR OF FAITH PILGRIMAGE

Please join Msgr. Robert E. Harahan and Fr. Maciek J. Zajac for an all-day Parish Pilgrimage to the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. on Saturday, October 26th, 2013. Bus will be leaving at 7am and we will join the rest of the Archdiocesan pilgrims in D.C. for a Carillon Concert, an Organ Concert, Recitation of the Rosary and a Holy Mass celebrated by Most Rev. John J. Myers, Archbishop of Newark. Bus will depart D.C. around 5pm.

The **Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception** honors the Blessed Virgin Mary as Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception, the principal Patroness of the USA.

Interestingly, the basilica is the largest Roman Catholic church in the United States, the twenty-first largest church building in the world, and the tallest habitable building in Washington, D.C. An estimated one million pilgrims from around the country and the world visit the basilica each year.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

RCIA is designed to welcome adults into our Catholic faith. Preparation is a year-long ongoing process culminating at the Easter Vigil Mass and Easter Season. The goal is to receive the Sacraments of Baptism (for non-Christians), Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

IS RCIA FOR YOU or SOMEONE YOU KNOW?

Do you know someone or are you someone who is interested in becoming Catholic or is a Catholic but has yet to receive all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist)? The RCIA is a process of prayer, reflection, and learning that allows for the continual discernment of God's will in our lives. Candidates include:

- Non-baptized adults who wish to enter the Catholic Church
- Baptized adult Christians of another denomination (i.e. Lutheran, Anglican, Presbyterian) who wish to continue their Christian faith in the Catholic Church.
- Adult baptized Catholics who have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Holy Communion and/or Confirmation) and wish to do so.
