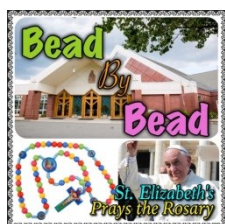
Gather the Children Program

Select Sundays at the 10:30 AM Mass: October 11 & 25, November 8 & 22, December 13 & 20 for children in Grades K-5

On select alternate Sundays, the Sunday Liturgy of the Word for Children, commonly referred to as "Gather the Children," will be offered. This program is geared to children in grades K – 5 and registration is not required. Children should be seated with their families in the church as usual. The priest will invite the children and their leaders to process to the Elizabeth Room at the beginning of Mass. The essential elements of the traditional Liturgy of the Word are retained, although the language of the readings is simplified using a special lectionary for children, approved by the Church. The liturgy includes the use of prayers, gestures, songs, and homiletics appropriate for children. The children return prior to the offertory to celebrate the Eucharist with the entire community. Parents should save their seats.

A Chance to Become Involved!

We are currently looking for volunteers in order to expand this program. Families like yours take turns leading the prayers and songs, proclaiming scripture, and discussing the Gospel with the children. The time commitment is minimal, one Sunday a month, from 10 AM to 11:45 AM. Best of all, your entire family can come and participate as part of the volunteer team. Older siblings can come and help too. It's a great opportunity to learn more about the mass while contributing to this important ministry. Jesus uses tough language that we may not want to hear. But, we are all called to be generous with all our gifts. Not just the ones we pick and choose, but all our gifts: our time in prayer to God, our talent in participating in parish ministries and our treasure supporting our local parish and other charities.



The gift of treasure for last weekend was \$24,002 (of which \$4,103 was from online giving) vs. our weekly budgeted amount of \$24,235. Year to date collections amounted to \$273,910 vs. our year to date budget of \$339,290.
